Return to Play

As per the Parent/Player code of conduct signed by all registered members, it is expected that members and their families will follow our Return to Play guidelines. Any breach of these guidelines may result in consequences for the players or members, including participation and status with the Association.

Event Guidelines

Please ensure that players arrive at sessions in full gear. All bags and bins should be left at the car. Water bottles should be labeled with the player name.

Arrival

- Coaches/Managers: arrive no more than 30 min prior to a session for set up.
- Players: 15 mins prior
- Players should enter and exit the practice location at the designated areas. (see pictures provided)
- There should be no gathering of parents at the practice location, social distancing guidelines must be followed as per municipal and provincial regulations.

Exit

- Teams need to exit in a timely manner so the next session can enter the facilities.
- No gathering of participants should occur after the sessions. And all participants must vacate the area within <u>10 mins of the session end time</u>.

- Players are to enter the box using the main entrance gate.
- If there is a group currently using the box, players should use the waiting area until the box has been cleared and the other team has vacated.

- Parents can wait for player no more that 5 min prior to end of practice. We ask that parents wait in the pickup area as long as 2 meters of space can be kept.
